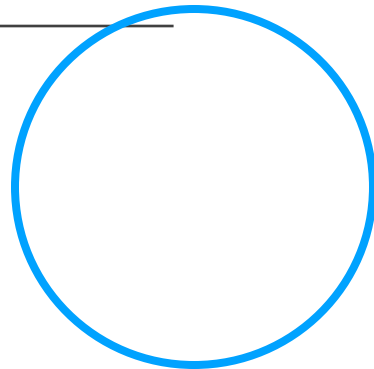


# Food Service update

Chef Joe also visited Turner High School and Turner Middle School to showcase a new recipe, street tacos. The students and staff enjoyed the tacos.

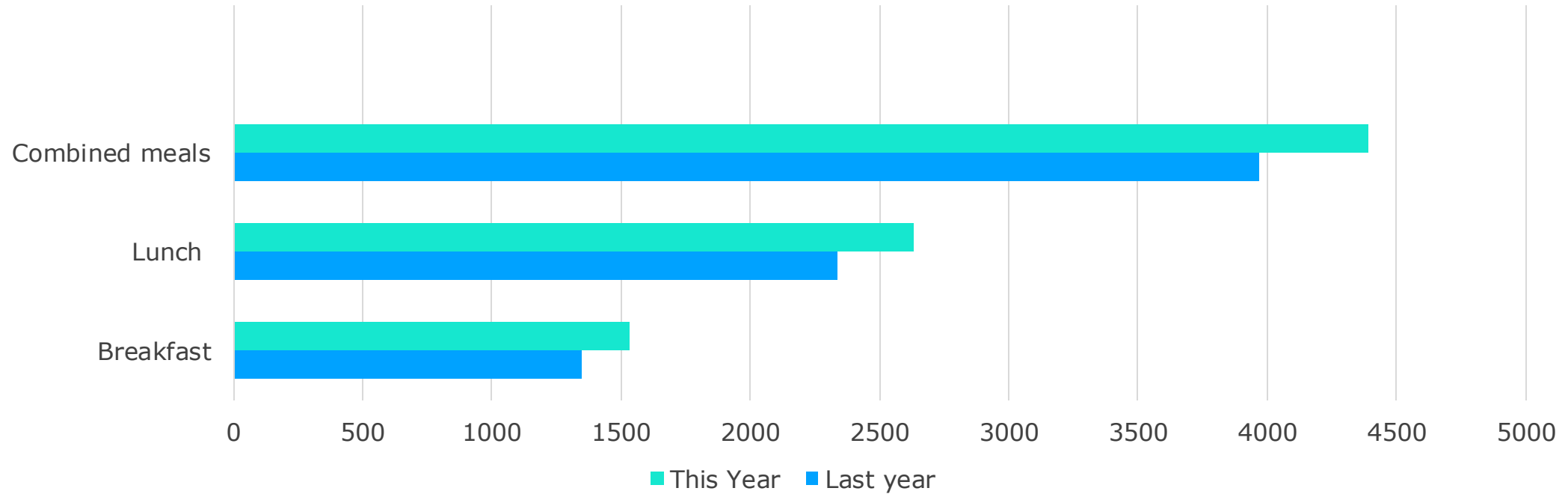
With soccer and football ending, we moved product from the DAC concession stands, to the concessions at Turner High School to prepare for girls and boys basketball session.

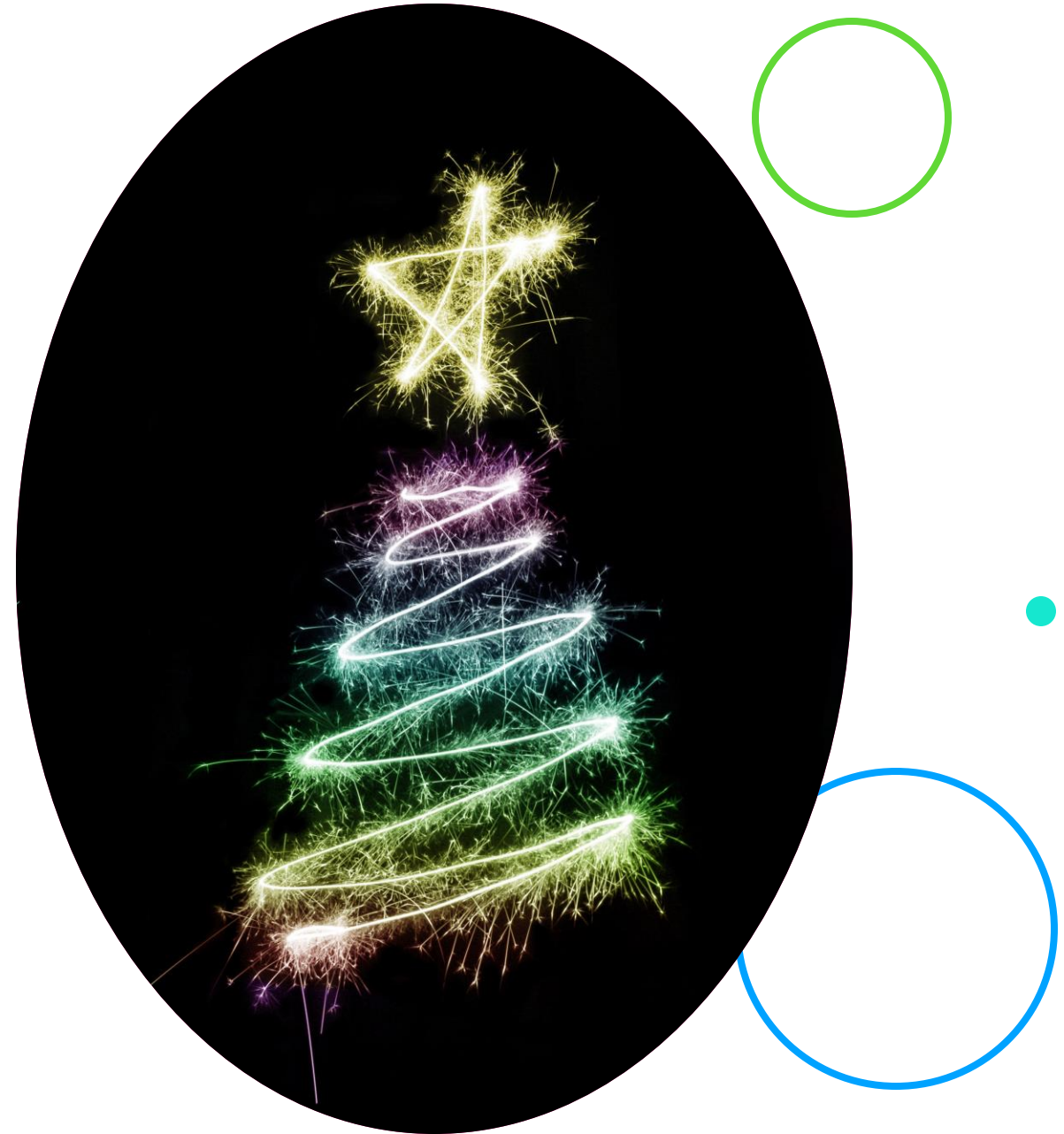


# DECEMBER UPDATE

In December our staff had a lot of fun with the students. From decorating kitchens, to elf on the shelf. Some of elementary students could not wait to see where the elf would be the next day.

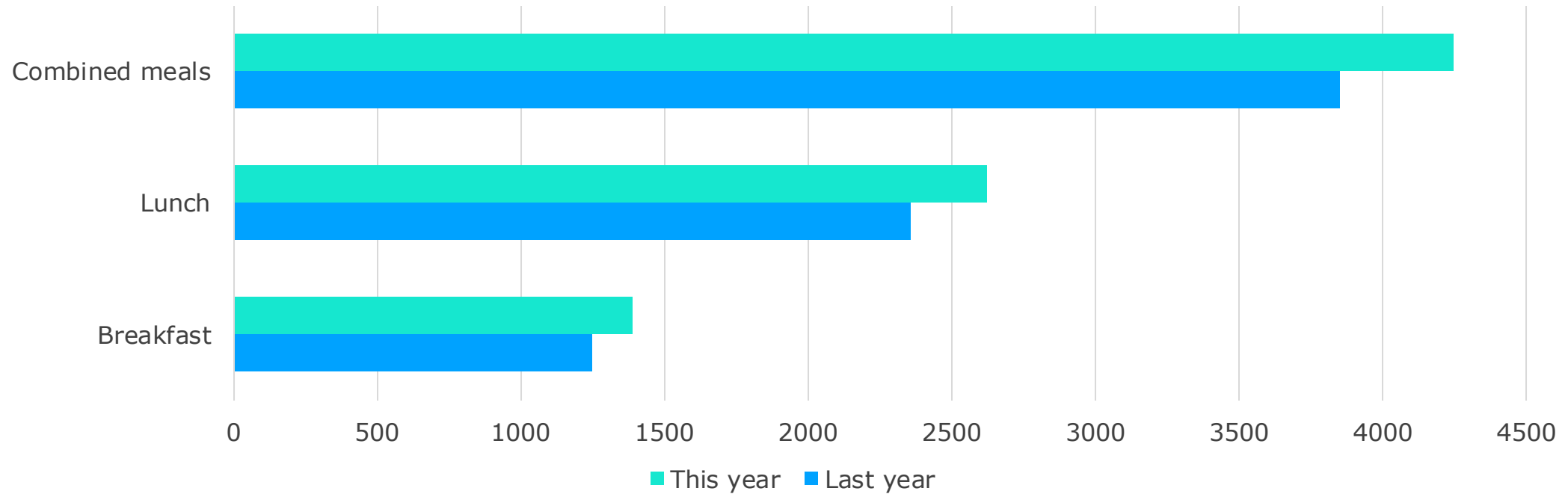

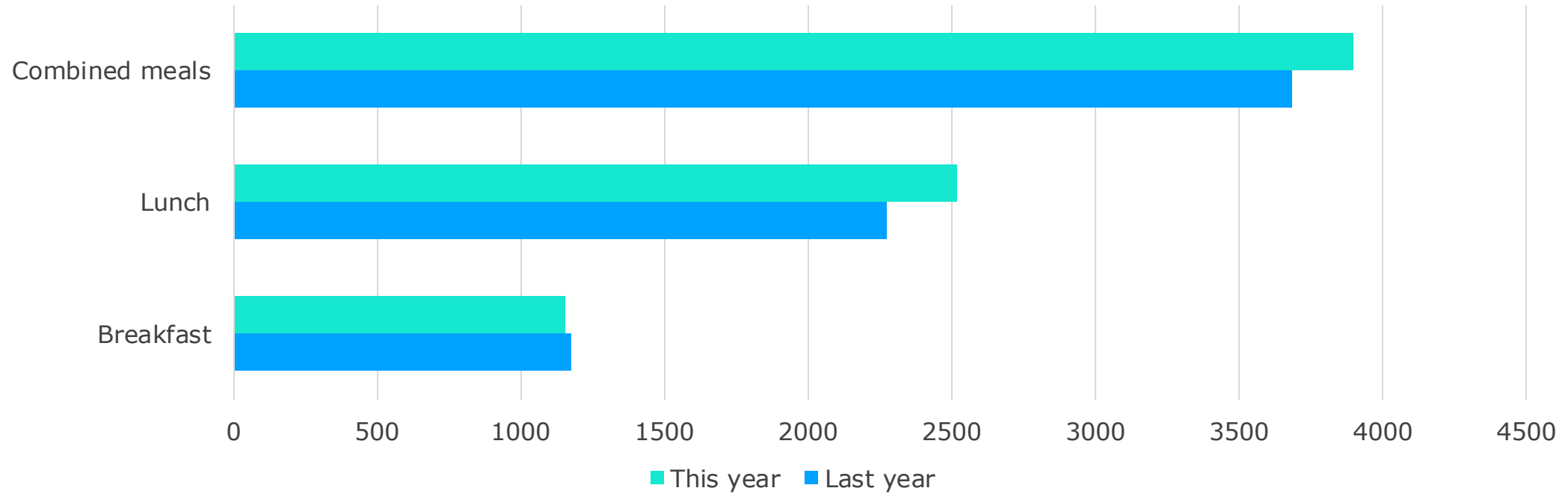
We also started our girls and boys basketball session and opened up the concession stands. Basketball has been pretty steady, especially once the band and cheerleaders get there.
