## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Master of Science in Special Education Teaching Degree is a licensure program designed for teachers who hold a valid teaching license. It is a 36 graduate credit hour, completely online program. The 36-hour program is designed to be completed in two years with six graduate credit hours of coursework being completed each semester. After successful completion of the program and Praxis examinations, candidates earn both High Incidence and Low Incidence teaching licenses.

#### **DISTRICT CONTRIBUTION**

The total cost of the two year program is \$13,464. USD 202 will pay the tuition cost for the fall and spring semesters, a total district contribution of \$8,976.

## **STAFF CONTRIBUTION**

Participants will be responsible for the cost of the six summer hours each year, which will be collected via a payroll deduction throughout the year. During the two years of participation, the district will deduct \$93.50 per paycheck (six summer hours at \$374 per hour = \$2,244 annually/24 pay periods is \$93.50).

To participate in this program, the USD 202 staff member must transfer to an open special education position in the 23 - 24 school year. If no positions are available, the staff member agrees to transfer to an open special education position in the 24 - 25 school year.
