The award of Valedictorian and Salutatorian will go to the graduating senior(s) with the highest 9 - 12 grade, eight-semester grade point average, through completion of the Kansas Scholars Curriculum, calculated to three decimal places. To qualify for the award of Valedictorian or Salutatorian, a student must attend a TUSD high school Turner High School their junior and senior year and complete

12 credits, not counting pass/fail credits. Students who transfer to <u>a TUSD high school Turner High School</u> from a state accredited school with a weighted grading system will have their <u>grade point average grades</u> calculated—weighting only courses equivalent to those <u>weighted in TUSD</u> by using the un-weighted grade from their previous school.

The student(s) who has the highest eight-semester grade point average and meets the above criteria will be named Valedictorian.

The student(s) who has the second highest eight-semester grade point average and meets the above criteria will be named Salutatorian.

If there is a tie, more than one student will be named Valedictorian or Salutatorian.

Rank in Class will be calculated for all students enrolled in a general education curriculum or a college preparatory curriculum.

This policy will take effect with the graduating class of 2013.
